New Medicare Cards Coming Soon

If you are "of a certain age", you are probably aware that Medicare is mailing new cards to its 60 million members. These new cards are significant because they will have newly-assigned ID numbers, rather than your Social Security number. *Your new Medicare Number is a unique combination of numbers and letters. Your new number uses numbers 0 thru 9. The letters S, L, O, I, B, and Z are never used.*

Medicare is distributing the new cards on a state-by-state basis and cards going to addresses in Florida will be mailed soon (to learn more about when your card will arrive, go to Medicare.gov/NewCard).

Your new card will automatically come to you. You don't need to do anything as long as your address is up to date. If you need to update your address, visit <https://www.ssa.gov> and log in to your account, or contact your Social Security Office. Once you get your new Medicare card, destroy your old Medicare card and start using your new card right away.

Beware of scams: Unfortunately, scammers posing as Medicare representatives are already calling beneficiaries demanding a processing fee, or requesting bank account information related to a refund. ***Medicare will never call you uninvited and ask you to give personal or private information to get your new Medicare Number and card.*** If someone asks you for your information, for money, or threatens to cancel your health benefits if you don't share your personal information, hang up and call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227).
