

UPDATE: St. Ben's Preschool

Changes are in the wind for St. Benedict's Preschool. Tammy Farmer has been the teacher for the school since it was started five years ago. Due to a number of family commitments, she has resigned that position effective July 24th. Some of the parents of St. Ben's students have come together to ensure that the school will open on schedule this Fall. A new board has been formed that will be

filled primarily with parents, and a new teacher has been hired for the coming year. While St. Ben's will no longer be a mission of Trinity Church, the vestry has agreed to allow the school to continue to lease the space in Benedict Hall for the next 10 months. Beginning in September of 2019, St. Ben's will officially close and students will be redirected to a new Montesorri school in Port St. Joe.

We wish to thank Tammy, her daughter Tammetrius, and all the volunteers that gave so much of their time and skills into this project. And, we hope for a bright future for all of the children that benefited from their time at St. Ben's.

Well the 4-H club creed says it all. It pledges a promise to serve community, country and the world, with head, heart, hands and health.




