Trinity Family Responds to Storm Needs

HURRICANE RECOVERY -- We have so much to be grateful for, given all the things that could have happened to Trinity and Apalachicola. While Trinity was relatively unscathed - a broken iron railing and blown-out fences, lots of limbs and debris, some shingles off the bell tower - we have some members and friends who were not quite so fortunate. Bayside docks, major appliances, stairs, were washed away. Four inches of mud and 14 feet of water in houses and lower levels were reported. Still in all, we have our lives, our loved ones and our friends. Some of us are more grief-stricken and traumatized than others. I ask your patience, gentleness, and prayers for them. This is not an event that will be forgotten and the after effects will linger for a long time.

Amidst all of the loss and heartache there are many bright spots: Trinity's 3-day free PopUp Daycare provided help for many families; and, Trinity, in partnership with Sarah Madson, Psy.D., held two one-hour listening and sharing times called *Beginning to Heal in the Aftermath of Hurricane Michael*; Over 35 residents of our area attended, and many volunteers who have pitched in for clean-up.

STEWARDSHIP -- We kicked off our annual Stewardship Campaign on Sunday, October 28 with Rennie Edwards leading the way. Rennie shared our theme for this year: **Transforming Generosity**. She captured the essence of how Trinity Church has been a transforming presence for her and Tom in their lives. She talked about the generosity of Trinity's outreach ministries and hospitality. Each of you has received a letter. Please prayerfully consider your offer of thanksgiving to Trinity for this coming year so Trinity can continue to be a **generous** and **transforming** presence in Apalachicola.

CLERGY GATHER IN APALACHICOLA -- Every month the clergy at the eastern end of the diocese (Santa Rosa Beach-Apalachicola) get together for fellowship and to break bread together. This month, November, Donna invited the clergy and the Bishop to come to Apalachicola. The Bishop is always a special guest, and we also have the Rev. Canon Carl Andrews and the Ven. Russ Oeschel, chaplains for Episcopal Relief and Development, as special guests who will be with us to talk about disaster response.
