Thanks to Lee Bettis, treasurer, Ron Harris and be Kristy Banks, our 2017 Audit is complete and has been submitted to the diocese.

Rennie Edwards, the Senior Warden is working on Church Bylaws from a template supplied by the diocese. Update: The By-laws are being circulated among the Vestry for approval. These will be kept here and be recorded at the diocese.

Penny's Worth:

New building signage is being worked on. Final approval and production is all that is needed.

Plans to do some much-needed repairs and upgrades to space using a generous gift from a parishioner. These projects include new flooring in the kitchen, upgrades to bathroom, a new dryer and new air conditioning unit.

St. Ben's Montessori Daycare/School is no longer a part of Trinity. The separation was effective August 10, 2018. The school is being directed by Jessica Sparks and Mimi Minnick is the new teacher. On June 1, 2019 the daycare/school will move to Port St. Joe as per an agreement made between previous St. Ben's Director and future director of the new WindMark Montessori in Port St. Joe.

Nancy Totman & I met with Franklin Co Schools re: music opportunities for HS students to sing in the Choir at Trinity and receive voice lessons. At this point, we have not heard from Franklin Co School.

Historic Documents Found in Safe

On July 25 we were able to get into the office safe that holds all of the records and important documents of the church. In the case of Trinity Church, Parish Registers, Vestry Minutes and budgets from 1836 are some of the documents we found. Churches keep these documents as a service and historical record for the



communities in which they are located. Church documents are a valuable asset when researching family history and the history of a settled area. These documents will be kept at Trinity Church and made available to the Florida State Archives for digital duplication so they will be preserved in perpetuity. Mrs. Dorothy (Dot) Greene Hill is a direct descendent of founding members of Trinity and settlers of Apalachicola. Her grandsons were the

7th generation of her family to be baptized in Trinity Church in November 2017.

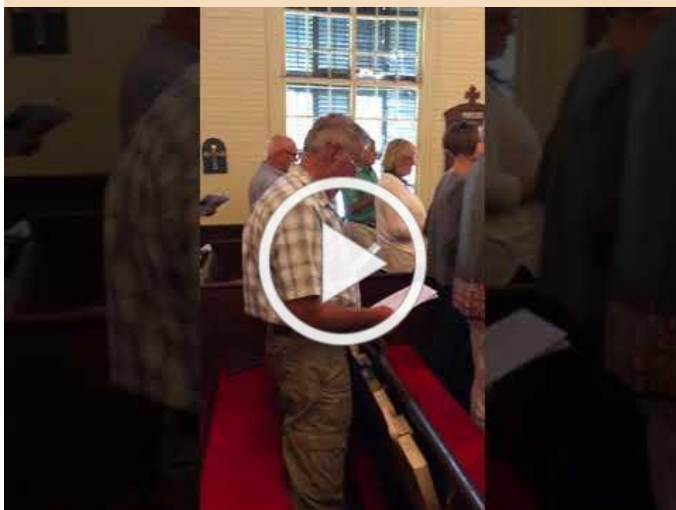


OUTREACH COMMITTEE TO PLAN FALL/WINTER PROGRAMS

While at the Apalachicola National Estuarine Research Reserve on the third Friday, the children learned that an estuary is where fresh water and salt water meet plus had loads of fun learning about marine life and other animals in the Apalachicola Bay. During the last Fantastic Friday the Apalachicola Main Street Trolley provided a fun ride to the Orman House. The kiddos participated in pictorial scavenger hunts while Ranger Mike shared highlights of the history of Apalachicola. A picnic lunch at the Apalachicola Center for History, Culture and Art followed by gelato at the Coffee and Chocolate Company ended the day with many smiles.

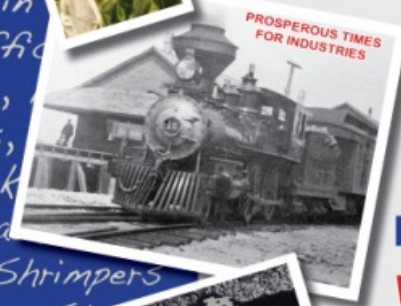

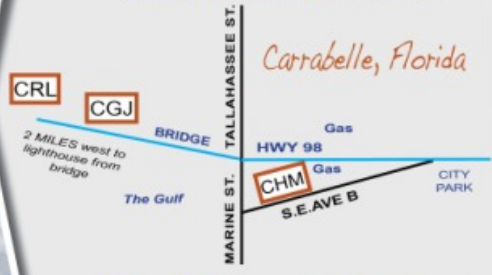
